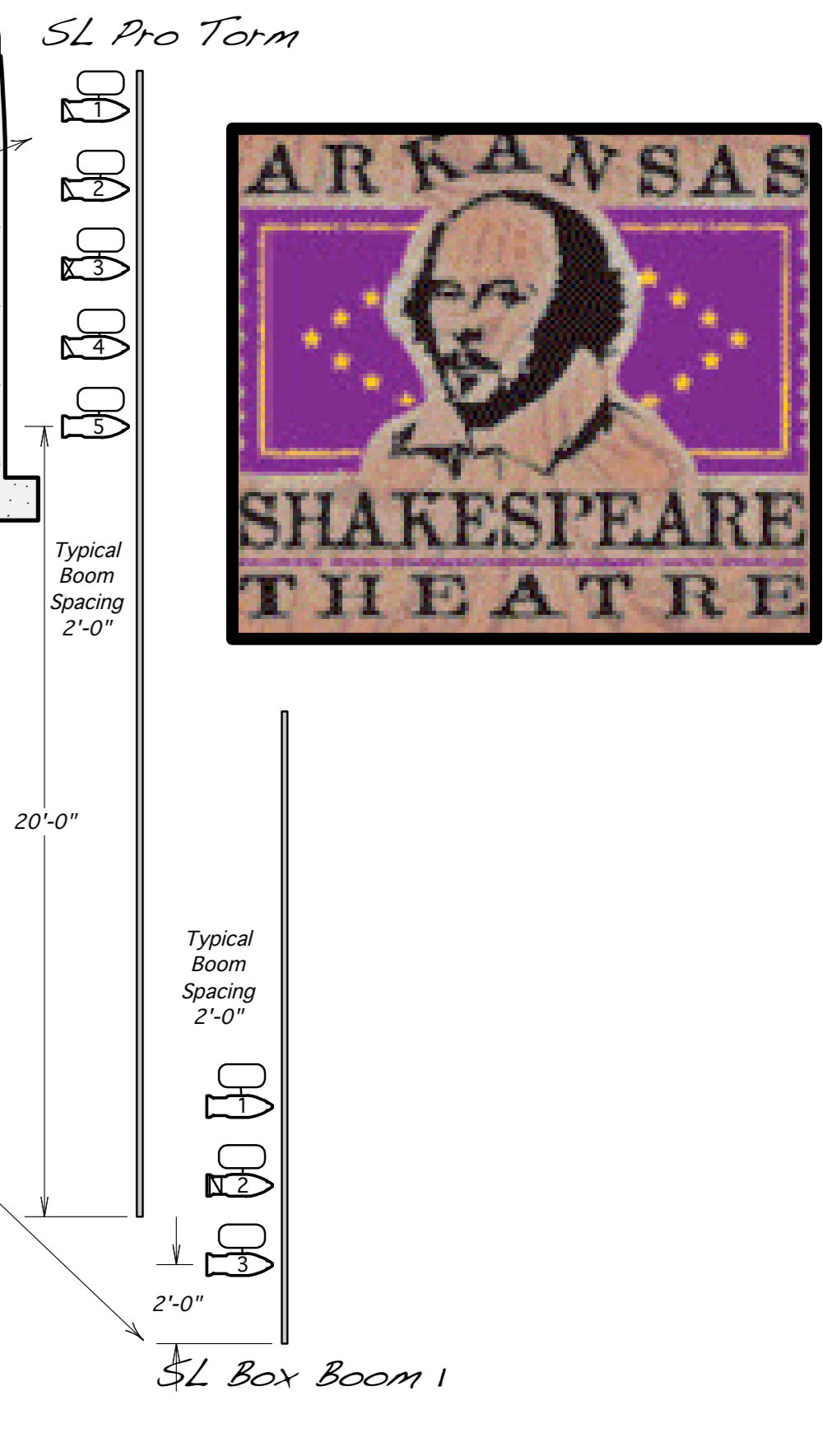
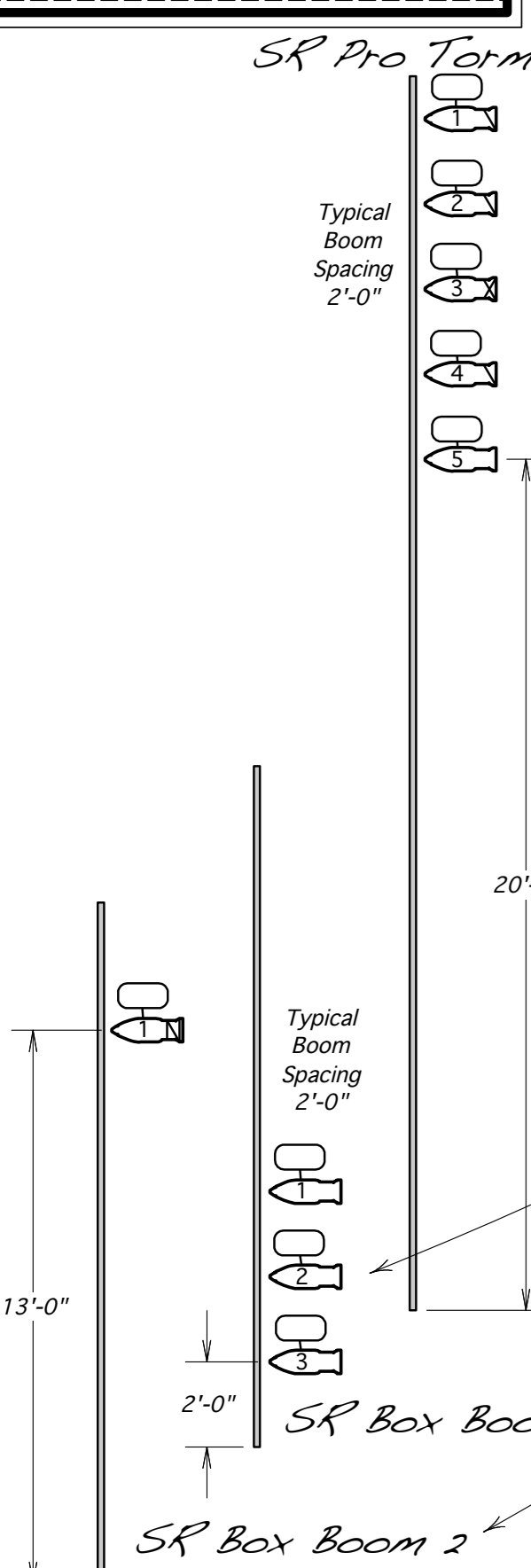


Notes:

- Units number from SL to SR, Top to Bottom, and away from the Plasterline.
- Heights for Booms/Torms are to the Center of the Lens.
- All floor runs of cable must be VERY NEAT!
- All units on Catwalk 1 are "Side Hung" on Lower Pipe EXCEPT Unit #29 which is "Piped Down" so the lens is below the catwalk, and the unit can focus into the house aisle. All indicated two-fers are at the Master Electrician's Option.
- Units which share a common circuit between shows are indicated with a two-fer.
- Trap Unit placement to be determined on-site by the Designer.
- Remove lenses from all four of the Macbeth Shadow units.
- Placement of Macbeth Shadows units to be determined on-site by director and designer.
- Moon Unit to be hung as far upstage as possible (against back wall), and trimmed out of sight (approx. 24' above stage level.)
- Typical boom spacing 2'-0"
